

TURN – Coffee Table

DESIGN INTENT

To develop a modern coffee table design for the home using minimal materials, creating a unique form, is functional and demands attention.

INSPIRATION

The TURN Table Design was inspired by the profile of a standard paper clip. The continuous line out of one piece of metal which had a great balance of form and function intrigued me.

I wanted to apply the singular composition of the paper clip, using one piece of material, into the design of a table.

The table will appear “legless” when the legs and table top are combined into one form.

FINAL DESIGN

The TURN Table is designed to have a fluid flow of contours from the top plane down to the side and legs and onto the middle shelf and back again to the other side.

Made out of 2 moulded pieces of glass sheet that combine to give the form structure, strength and stability.

The clear glass accentuates the curved design of the legs from one side to the other.

Environmental Friendliness

The TURN Table is designed with the environment in mind. It is made of recyclable glass and is designed to be easily assembled and disassembled. Its stainless steel feet offset fasteners are also recyclable.

Ease of Manufacture

The TURN Table is produced locally in Australia. The Glass is heat formed over a mould, rebated and finished. The stainless steel offset fasteners used for the legs of the TURN Table are locally supplied.
